## The following is additional information of the Muma College of Business:

- The Muma College of Business has a SEPARATE APPLICATION PROCESS from that of the University of South Florida. Please allow enough time to apply and receive acceptance to USF before applying to the Muma College of Business.
- All applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 and have completed all seven state mandated prerequisite courses prior to starting at USF.
- Finance majors must earn a grade of C, NOT C-, or better in FIN 3403 within two attempts. A withdrawal counts as an attempt.
- All pre-requisite courses must be completed with a C, NOT C-, or better, but maintain a 2.50 GPA or better within the
  prerequisite courses.
- Students must earn a grade of C- or better in all business courses, but must maintain a 2.00 GPA or
